

SPARKLING

Sparkling wine can be very different stylistically reflecting their place of origin. Prosecco is only made in Italy and is generally light and crisp with mild fruit characteristics. Sparkling rosé is made in contact of the skins and has deeper acidity and broader body. True Champagne from Champagne, France houses the most expensive, exquisite bubbles in the world.

RIESLING

Riesling originated in the Rhine region of Germany and is an aromatic grape variety displaying flowery, almost perfumed, aromas as well as high acidity. Riesling can be dry, semi-sweet, sweet and/or sparkling.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Depending on how ripe the Sauvignon Blanc grapes are when the wine is made, the flavor will range from zesty lime to flowery peach. What makes Sauvignon Blanc unique from other white wines are its other herbaceous flavors like bell pepper, jalapeño, gooseberry and grass.

CHARDONNAY

The Chardonnay grape is very neutral, with many of the flavors commonly associated with the grape being derived from such influences as terroir and oak. It can be lean, crisply and mineral with noticeable acidity and flavors of green plum, apple, and pear. Or in warmer locations, the flavors become fat developing a buttery profile.

ROSÉ

Rosé happens when the skins of red grapes touch wine for only a short time. Where some red wines ferment for weeks at a time on red grape skins, rosé wines are stained red for just a few hours. Rosé is the red wine lovers' chosen drink of white.

SHIRAZ/SYRAH

Let's clear something up right away: Syrah and Shiraz are the exact same wine. When Syrah (Sih-Rah) arrived in Australia from its birthplace in France, Australian winemakers took to calling it Shiraz (Shi-RAZ), instead of the grape's original name, Syrah.

ZINFANDEL

Zinfandel is a wine truly made famous by California. The Zinfandel grape creates a big, ripe red wine that comes with some of the highest alcohol content of any red wine on the market (between 14 and 17 percent). Zinfandels have come to be known for their jammy, fruity characteristics.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

In cooler climates, Cabernet tends to produce wines with blackcurrant notes that can be accompanied by mint and cedar. In more moderate climates the blackcurrant notes are often seen with black cherry and black olives notes while in very hot climates the current flavors can veer towards the over-ripe and "jammy" side.
